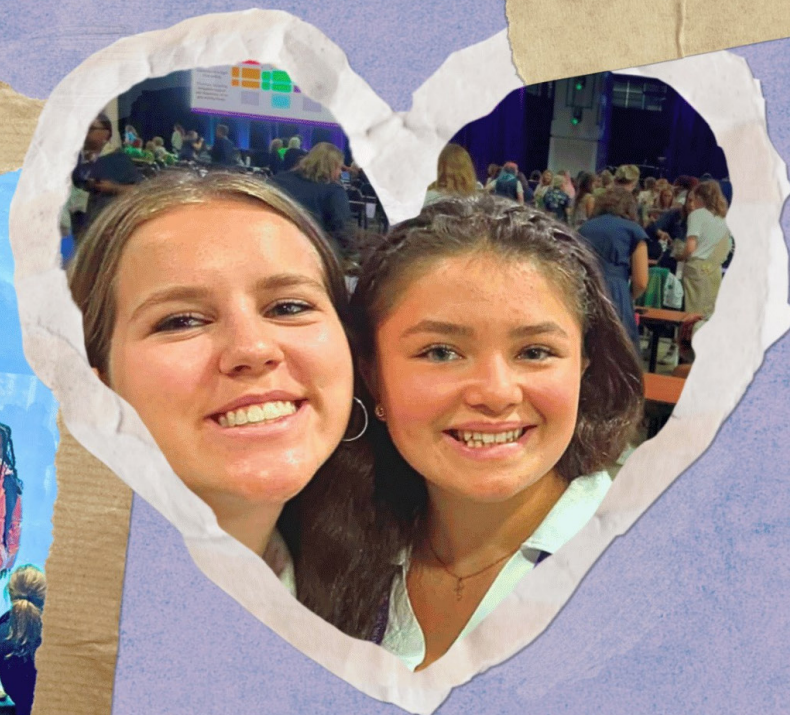




Using this Guide

Family Engagement **Family**

The whole family can join in the fun! There are lots of ways families can be involved in Girl Scouts, and sometimes that means enjoying an outing together. These events are open for the whole gang to come along as their Girl Scout discovers the world. Everyone shares the fun when a family sees an event through a Girl Scout's eyes! Family events show the various costs for Girl Scouts, adults, and tagalongs. Tagalongs are siblings or friends (both boys and girls) who join an event or program, accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Patch of the Month

Each month, girls can Discover, Connect, and Take Action in a specific subject area. Hands-on activities are available for all Girl Scout levels and can be done at meetings, as a pre-meeting activity, or as an at-home project.

Completing patch programs may satisfy requirements for certain badges. It's not necessary to complete the patch programs in the months specified—they can be completed at any time.

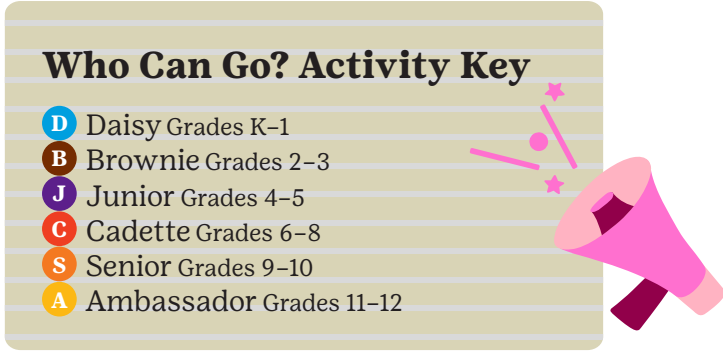
