- Round 2 January 29 – 10:30am – 11:59pm EST (8 spots)
- Round 3 January 30 – 10:30am – 11:59pm EST (12 spots)
- January 31 – 10:30am All Open/No Limits

# **How to sign up in eBudde**

## **Booth Sales Tab**

### **Council Booth available in eBudde**

- Click on the Booth Sales tab in eBudde.
- Sign up for a Council Booth.
- City, Location, Date, Time.
- Submit.

### **Troop Booth Add in eBudde**

- Add/Edit a Troop Booth
- +Add
- Business name, Address, Contact, Date, Time.
- Pending Approval will remain until it has been approved.

Your selections will appear on your dashboard.

# Kentuckiana Credits

- SU earn 20 KC for every unique booth location submitted to the council by **February 2**.
- Troops earn 20 KC for every 100 packages ordered for booths from Jan. 12 – Feb. 2. (Orders on the booth line of the initial order tab in eBudde)

## **How You Can Help**

- Troops connect with your local service unit volunteer team.
- Council will secure cookie booths in your area at Kroger & Walmart locations.
- Think outside the box – Are there places you have not approached? Restaurants, tanning salons.
- Arrange a drive through booth at a busy location.
- SU/Council will secure booths that you can include in the open council booth draw (most troops will stay within their nearest neighborhoods and areas for booths and want to go to the stores they frequent as customers).
- SU booth draw then submit to council to load into eBudde.
- SU/Council will quickly approve My Sale/Troop booth requests in eBudde so troops can make plans.
