



Operation: Cookie, a “Sweet” Way to Say Thank You!

What is Operation: Cookie?

Operation: Cookie is our council-wide “gift of caring” donation program. Supporters make a monetary donation to purchase Girl Scout Cookies that will be sent to US Military servicepersons both at home, across the United States, and sometimes overseas! It is a “sweet” way to say thank you to those who serve.

How Does Operation: Cookie help support a Girl Scout troop?

When a supporter makes a donation for Girl Scout Cookies, the total cookies purchased with an Operation: Cookie donation count towards a Girl Scout’s cookie sales goal, and the troop earns proceeds for each package donated!

How Much is an Operation: Cookie Donation?

The cost of a donation starts at \$6 a package. A supporter can donate a full case of 12 packages for \$72.

How Can Someone Support Operation: Cookie?

Donations are in increments of \$6 (the price of a core-flavor cookie), and supporters can ask that the donation go to Operation: Cookie. This is a great option for those avoiding sugar or those who have already purchased cookies!

Supporters may also donate through a Girl Scout’s Digital Cookie link online. Another great way to help is by hosting a cookie booth and displaying a donation box with Operation: Cookie information!

When is the 2025 Girl Scout Cookie Program?

Girl Scouts start selling January 1, 2025. Cookie booths will be active February 21–March 30, 2025.
