

Autumn Training Blast at Camp Shantituck October 7 – 9, 2022

A series of trainings will be offered at Camp Shantituck during the weekend of October 7-9, 2022. We are calling this weekend Autumn Training Blast – a “blast” of 27 separate trainings offered throughout the weekend. You may register for only one training, or several, or as many as you can fit into your schedule! If you take more than one class, in between classes you can relax, take a hike, go out to eat at a nearby restaurant with Girl Scout friends, and otherwise enjoy your time at camp.

Registration and costs: You will register for each training separately. For most trainings, registration deadline is midnight on Wednesday, Oct. 5. **Earlier registration deadlines are noted in the course description.** **NOTE:** Some classes have a required minimum number of participants and will be cancelled if that number is not met. There are maximum capacities too. Notifications about cancellations will be sent as soon as possible after the registration deadline for the class and in all cases by no later than Thursday evening, October 6. **Many trainings offered are FREE**, given at no charge. Other trainings, especially trainings which involve preparation of food but also some trainings which require materials and supplies, have fees to cover costs, and you will pay for those separately. Who can attend: The trainings for this weekend are planned for adults. Ambassador Girl Scouts may attend if they are planning to pursue the Volunteer-in-Training program as they transition to adult roles in Girl Scouting. Ambassadors who register need to be supervised by an adult present at the trainings.

Overnight stays: Participants who wish to stay overnight at camp rather than “come and go” are welcome to stay in one of the buildings (Cardinal Lodge or Denham House) or tent units (Ivy Grove, Pines, and Knobs) we have reserved for that purpose. You choose your location; no assignments will be made. We are reserving Pine Lair and Sinawik in case there are special needs we must accommodate; we will have a camp hostess on site who will deal with any special requests.

Food: During this weekend, no food services will be provided at camp for participants (except for those trainings where food preparation is part of the training itself). Those participants who stay for an entire day of training or overnight at camp will be responsible for bringing their own food, preferably ready-to-eat or easy to microwave. Cooking in camp kitchens is discouraged due to cleanup issues. Ice is available in the institutional kitchen in Cardinal Lodge, and refrigeration space will be available in Cardinal Lodge and Denham House. Microwaves for re-warming food are in all camp buildings, and there are many restaurants within just a few miles of camp.

Expectations: All participants are expected to follow the Girl Scout Promise and Law while at camp and act accordingly. Part of being responsible for what you say and do is to follow council policies regarding safety and use of our properties. Leaving camp: Come and go as needed to take trainings. Unless you are still involved in a training on Sunday, please leave camp by no later than 12 noon on Sunday, 10/8. **If you stayed overnight, make sure you help clean your building.** Last person out of any building should remove all trash in kitchens/bathrooms and take to dumpster.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 7th

American Red Cross CPR Adult/Child, AED, and First Aid. Friday, October 7, 7:00 – 9:00 pm EDT. ***Registration deadline is September 29.*** Learn basic first aid, adult and child CPR, and AED procedures. Many Girl Scout activities outside of regular troop meetings require a First Aid/CPR trained adult. **This class will be conducted both online and in person.** When the instructor has the class roster, she will enter data into the American Red Cross site. Then ARC will send you a link to watch the CPR and First Aid videos online ahead of your in-person class. After watching the videos, you will receive an emailed certificate from ARC. Please email a copy of that to Kelley at kelleyschleg36@gmail.com or print it out and bring it with you. **Cost: \$35, payable to the instructor (cash or check).** Most of the course fee goes to the ARC and the rest is for consumables. Brownie/Junior Grade Level. Friday, October 7, 7:30 - 9:30 pm EDT. No matter the grade level, in Girl Scouts, girls lead. This Brownie/Junior course will help you help girls find their voice with programs created especially for them. Girl Scout Grade Level courses guide you through the grade level resources like Journeys, girl awards, and council programs, in this case Brownie and Junior grade levels. You will become an expert in what it means to have “girl-led programming,” with insight to Girl Scout traditions including the girl uniform and be able to discuss grade level appropriate activities. Camp In Part A. Friday, October 7, 7:00 – 10:00 pm EDT. Camp In Part A is the first half of GSK’s Camp In class. Camp In Part A authorizes you to take a troop/group on day outings at our camp properties and other natural settings but does not include fire-building or other outdoor heated cooking. You will learn about girl readiness, progression, planning, properties, hiking, and emergencies. Making Box Ovens!! Friday, 10/7/2022, 7:30 - 9:30 pm EDT. Did you know you can cook in a cardboard box? Come learn about types of box ovens from the most basic to pretty fancy! You will learn how to make several kinds, and the class will work together to make at least two box ovens. Then we'll have a drawing, and the lucky winner(s) will take home a box oven built by the class. Everyone will get copies of box oven designs to take home. SATURDAY, OCTOBER 8th

American Red Cross CPR Adult/Child, AED, and First Aid. Saturday, October 8, 11:30 am - 3:30 pm EDT. Learn basic first aid, adult and child CPR, and AED procedures. Many Girl Scout activities outside of regular troop meetings require a First Aid/CPR trained adult. This class is completely an in-person class and is a great class especially for those who have not had a first aid/CPR class in the past. **Cost: \$35, payable to the instructor (cash or check).** Most of the course fee goes to the ARC and the rest is for consumables. Archery for Fun. Saturday, October 8, 2022, 9:00 - 10:30 am EDT. Have you ever wanted to give archery a try but never had the opportunity? Do you want to do some target practice? Or do you want to become an archery instructor, but you've never held a bow in your hand? This "archery for fun" class can get you started from scratch or allow you chances to shoot around just for fun. A USA Archery Instructor will be there to give you tips. Even if you are new, by the time this session is over, you will know enough to complete the practicum part of the USA Archery class given right after this "archery for fun" session. (NOTE: See description below for USA Archery Level I certification, including that you MUST do on-line work and pass a test before taking the practicum.) Archery Instructor Practicum (USA Archery Level 1). Saturday, 10/8/2022, 10:30 am - 2:30 pm EDT. This class is for students who have passed/will pass their USA Archery level I Instructor certification online and need to test out on the practicum course. You will need to pay a separate \$40 fee directly to USA Archery for the on-line portion. Each participant will receive an email with specific instructions to follow to sign up for the online course. Participants need to plan on setting aside at least 8 hours to complete the on-line portion of the training. Your trainer will contact you with more details about the class and will either talk to you individually or schedule a zoom meeting to cover class details. Then you will take this practicum portion of the class to complete the certification process. Certification by USA Archery is good for 3 years and is renewable for 3 more years with documented experience. Prerequisites: You must complete the online portion and pass a test before taking this practicum class at camp. **Cost: \$40 to USA Archery; \$10 for practicum, payable to council via payment link** Registration link - <https://form.jotform.com/222348679755168>

Camp In Part B, Saturday October 8, 2022, 9:00 am - 1:30 pm EDT. **Registration deadline: October 2.** Camp In Part B authorizes you to take troops camping overnight in winterized buildings. Learn fire safety (preparation and extinguishing), fire building with girls, foil and stick cooking, safe use of charcoal, general safety precautions, and building cleanup. Camp In B is valid for five years or until you complete Camp Out or Outdoor Update, whichever comes first. Prerequisite: Camp In Part A. **Cost: \$8, payable to council via payment link.** Registration link - <https://form.jotform.com/222326193034145>

Camp In Part B - Hybrid version: See course description immediately above. This version of the class is done via a combination of a virtual live webinar session of about 1.5 - 2 hours, some video-watching on your own, and an in-person session of about 2 - 2.5 hours where you will cook a supper meal. This particular session will provide hands-on experience in building a race car (Daisy Model Car and Brownie Race Car) but the process is applicable to all levels.
